The Convention will not be able to provide overhead projectors since the rental cost has become prohibitive. You are encouraged to make arrangements with a school for your overhead needs. VCR/DVD players and LCD projectors should be requested only if they are critical to your presentation. **There is no additional fee for exhibiting organizations to present programs, however exhibitors must provide their own audio-visual equipment.**

Educators attending the Science Convention will be eligible to receive credit toward their State mandated 100 hours of professional development.
